

# 'European Grand Slam' Belgique

## SPECIFIC RULES FOR 2006

These Specific Rules are relating to the 'EUROPEAN GRAND SLAM' BELGIQUE.

Approved by the Management Committee, they complete for this event the General Rules.

### 1. THE TEAMS

#### 1.1. NUMBER OF TEAMS

A maximum of 30 competing teams will be accepted for 2006, with priority given to teams competing in the whole 'EUROPEAN GRAND SLAM' tournament.

The entry requests for teams to enter only the 'EUROPEAN GRAND SLAM' BELGIQUE will be handled in accordance with the date of their reception and the 'EUROPEAN GRAND SLAM' General Rules modalities.

#### 1.2. TEAM ENTRIES

**Closing date: March 15th 2006.**

Entry fees: 180 € per team.

Formalities (see the General Rules for addresses):

- Belgium, Dutch and Luxemburg teams entries must be lodged with the Belgium office holder (payment by swift to : 'FVV 783-5605762-82 , Weverstraat 33, 9220 Hamme');
- English, Scottish, Welsh and Irish teams entries must be lodged with the Management Committee office holder representing England;
- Other teams entries must be lodged with the French office holder (for the French teams: payment by cheque to 'FCC' - for other countries: payment by swift without any charge to the recipient to 'FCC, Banque Populaire, 78940 La Queue-lez-Yvelines, IBAN n° FR-76-1870-7000-7309-0214-0722-788, BIC n° CCBPFRPPVER').

A completed entry form based on the enclosed model must be sent for each team.

### 2. THE DRAW

The draw for the starting pegs for each team competitor shall take place on Saturday, **06th of May at 16 hours**, in the presence of the captain countries who wish to assist.

### 3. THE COMPETITION

#### 3.1. DATE AND VENUE

The 'EUROPEAN GRAND SLAM' BELGIQUE 2006 will be held on **Sunday, 07th of May** at the lake of Freux located at Freux (Libramont - Belgium).

#### 3.2. PROCEDURE

The first round will run from 09 hours to 12 hours 30 and the second round from 13 hours 45 to 17 hours 15.

There will be five pegs per round, with 30 minutes fishing at each peg and 15 minutes to change pegs.

***NB: A 'lunch bag' will be given to the competitors. Its price is included in the entry fees.***

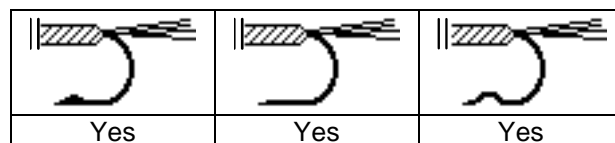
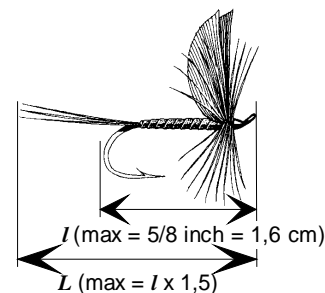
### 3.3. FISHING METHOD AND TACKLE

See the General Rules for 'EUROPEAN GRAND SLAM', 'bank fishing' section.

Please note the following points:

Leader: All types of leaders, of any density, are permitted - Any additional weight is prohibited.

Flies: Maximum number per line: 4 - Only single hooks are authorised - Minimum distance between two flies: 20 inches (50 cm) - Maximum hook size: 5/8 inch (1.6 cm), eye included - Maximum fly size: one and one half times the length of the hook - Weighted flies are prohibited. Hooks must be barbless or have their barb completely compressed.



In the event of dispute, the fly shall be kept by the marshal and submitted to the Management Committee, which is the sole body authorized to arbitrate.

- Note: - It is forbidden to fish diagonally outwards from the edges of the peg;  
 - It is forbidden to enter into the water;  
 - It is forbidden to receive help from anyone.

The fishing method will be 'no kill'.

### 4. PRESENTATION OF PRIZES

Sunday, 07th of May at a manor house near the lake of Freux.

### 5. MISCELLANEOUS

#### 5.1. TRAINING

Fishing on the lake of Freux will be prohibited for all competitors for 4 full days before the competition.
